The Governors of the Charity will meet in late October, to review and approve grant applications, and if you have been successful, you should receive your payment by early November. Please note the Bank Account Name is the name of the account holder, i.e., **your name** or that of a **parent**, and **NOT** the name of the bank, e.g., NatWest.

To be eligible for a grant:

- Your **permanent/home address** must be in the old Parish of Whittington, (New/Old Whittington, Sheepbridge, Whittington Moor, **east side**, or the Brushes).
- You must be studying a **full-time course** in the sixth form, at college or university, which lasts at least **one academic year**.
- Be no more than **19 years old**.
- You may apply only **ONCE**.

Your application will **only** be considered if:

- Your application is signed by your tutor **AFTER** you have started your course.
- You **give us your permission** to check that you have taken your place on the course.
- You have provided all the information requested in this form.
